a. Ability Inc.- Ms. Lori Schaedler, Executive Director, announced that Early Intervention has added a speech and language pathologist. Ms. Clara Wilson has joined the Early Intervention Advisory Board. Life Ops continues to grow, they have added a behavior

specialist and are working on their waitlist. Ms. Schaedler also announced that two ISLs have been consolidated in part due to staffing shortages. Ms. Schaedler is looking at other opportunities to fill consumer's needs in the area of residential. Housing may also be available to staff working with consumers at a discounted rate which could help with the direct support professional crisis. In the area of community supports, the summer bowling league has ended, transportation and personal assistants are filling needs. Ability is utilizing Charting the Life Course to track data and outcomes.
