Treasurer's Report- Ms. Amanda Sammet, Accountant, presented the February 2026 financial reports. The report was received and placed on file.

Executive Director's Report- Ms. Kimberlyn MacDonald reported that the Service Coordination team attended Disability Rights legislative Day in Jefferson City on February 25, 2026. Ms. MacDonald reported on some of the topics discussed by Service Coordinators with the legislators during their visit to the capital. These topics included safeguarding property taxes that support local disability services, noting that Franklin County SB40 generates approximately \$2.4–\$2.5 million in annual revenue through local tax levies. Ms. MacDonald also reported discussion regarding the proposed \$80.7 million reduction in Missouri disability services funding and the potential local impact. In Franklin County, this funding currently supports 50 individuals in Self-Directed Services, 153 individuals in Day Habilitation Services, and 4 individuals in Community Specialist Services. Additionally, Ms. MacDonald noted discussion about eliminating the waiver waiting list, with 7

individuals in Franklin County currently awaiting services and a total of 277 individuals state-wide. Ms. MacDonald reported on staff, consumer, and waiver totals. The report was received and placed on file.

New Business- None

Old Business – SB40 Building Loan Payoff Statement and Resolution – Members of the board reviewed the documents. Documents placed on file.
