**ABiLITY-DSFC, Inc. Request for Shift in Funds** – Ms. Lori Schaedler, Executive Director, reported on the need to shift FY2026 funds by moving \$33,000 from Early Intervention Program to Life Ops Day Habilitation and \$8,000 from Community Supports Program to Residential Services Program.

MOTION was made by Mr. Mark Hagen, seconded by Mr. Steve Wilmesherr, to approve ABiLITY-DSFC, Inc FY2026 request to shift \$33,000 from Early Intervention Program to Life Ops Day Habilitation and \$8,000 from Community Supports Program to Residential Services Program. Motion carried (7-0)

**Bid Opening-Financial Audit**

MOTION was made by Mr. Steve Wilmesherr, seconded by Ms. Katherine Chambers, to accept the bid from Tochtrop & Associates in the amount of \$8600 for the FY2026 Financial Audit. Motion carried (7-0)

**Treasurer's Report-** Ms. Amanda Sammet, Accountant, presented the March 2026 financial reports. The report was received and placed on file.

**Executive Director's Report:** Ms. Kimberlyn MacDonald reported on the FY2027 Missouri budget updates. Ms. MacDonald provided state budget updates and reported that the Missouri General Assembly has passed the \$50.7 billion state budget for the 2027 fiscal year (FY2027) on May 6, 2026. Ms. MacDonald went on to report that Governor Mike Kehoe has until June 30, 2026, to sign the FY2027 operating budget and use his line-item veto power, ensuring the budget is in place for the new fiscal year beginning July 1. Ms. MacDonald reported on the Missouri Senate Bill 3 (SB3). Ms. MacDonald highlighted the Missouri SB3 tax credits passed in 2025 and the threat it has on sustainability of local taxing entities, SB3 requiring Missouri counties to vote on a property tax credit that freezes or caps homeowner tax increases, and the 17 counties exempt from the property tax provisions. Ms. MacDonald reported on the SB3 April 2026 election results. Ms. MacDonald reported on the Legislative updates highlighting the Missouri House joint resolutions 172 and 174, House Bill 3467-Developmental Disability Sales Tax, Medicaid (MO HealthNet) work requirements, and RJ's law (House Bill 1840). The report was received and placed on file.

### **New Business**

- a. Ron Kruse Building Cove Joint Crack Repair -Members of the board reviewed the estimate to repair the cove joint crack at the Ron Kruse building.

MOTION was made by Mr. Steve Wilmesherr and seconded by Mr. Mark Hagen to repair the cove joint crack at the Ron Kruse building. Motion carried (7-0)

- b. Tax Increment Financing Commission of Washington MO.- Members of the board reviewed the Tax Increment Financing Commission letter from the city of Washington, Missouri and the plan for an industrial development project and cost/benefit analysis. Information was received and placed on file.
